**SUBJECT:** **11TH DAY ENROLLMENT COUNT SY2021-22 (FY2022)**

The first official enrollment count of the 2021-22 school year was tabulated on Tuesday, August 24, 2021. The 11th Day Count is used primarily for school staffing purposes. The October FTE count will provide more stabilized enrollment data for planning and FTE purposes. This report typically compares the 11<sup>th</sup> day enrollment to the prior school year, however, due to the delayed start of the 2020-2021 school year, an 11th day enrollment count was not compiled.

### ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

Total SY2021-22 11th day PreK-12 enrollment for traditional District-operated schools was **165,822** students. For all District schools, total PreK-12 enrollment was **191,011 students**. Table 1 summarizes the enrollment data.
