SUBJECT: **11TH DAY ENROLLMENT COUNT SY2022-23 (FY2023)**

The first official enrollment count of the 2022-23 school year was tabulated on Thursday, August 25, 2022. The 11th Day Count is used primarily for school staffing purposes. The October FTE count will provide more stabilized enrollment data for planning and FTE purposes.

ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

Total PreK-12 enrollment for traditional District operated schools was 166,172 students, an increase of 350 students from last year's 11th day enrollment. For all schools, 11th day PreK-12 enrollment increased by 292 students to 189,791 students; pre-kindergarten enrollment was 3,606 students. Table 1 summarizes the enrollment data.
