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WELCOME BACK !

Moving into the new school year, principals and school staff will face the challenge of setting school-selected targets and objectives for the FY2012 school year. Annually, each school's principal and leadership team are required to develop School Improvement Objectives for the School Improvement Plan. School Improvement Plans analyze student data to determine systemic weaknesses among the student body as a whole, and among certain subgroups specified by NCLB, such as English Language Learners, Student With Disabilities, and Economically Disadvantaged students.

School Improvement Plans include objectives that will help the staff improve outcomes for the students. Writing a successful School Improvement Plan means carefully selecting appropriate objectives for each individual school's circumstances, while analyzing relevant data. In order to support schools in this target setting and monitoring of progress toward meeting the targets, the Educational Data Warehouse (EDW) Team provides schools with several monitoring reports (see below). For further assistance, contact an EDW Specialist to assist with setting your school's school-selected targets.

When requesting EDW assistance via email include the following information: your employee payroll name, type of EDW access, school name, telephone number where you may be reached, report name, and number. If the request pertains to an individual student, include the student's first and last name initials and identification number. If the request pertains to a specific class, include the teacher's course code and section number. Also, forward a screen print of the error message.

HOT PICKS FOR STARTING THE SCHOOL YEAR

Accelerated Participation in AP (Advanced Placement)-RTSUA0405

The reports indicate students and percentage of students who have the potential for success in AP courses. In addition, there is a report that identifies students who have met CollegeBoard's eligibility criteria for participation in AP courses based on their previous FCAT DSS scores.

Accountability

The reports display the most recent FCAT Reading, Math, Writing, and Science results; Fall and Winter Diagnostic Reading, Math, and Science results; and SRI results for accountable students enrolled in the school.

Course Percent Summary-RITOA0130

The report maybe used to monitor enrollment in upper level courses, including AP, IB, and dual enrollment courses. The report displays information related to student enrollment in courses and distribution of NCLB groups throughout the courses.

Discipline

The reports are viewed to track discipline counts, such as OSS days, ISS days, and student days present/absent. In addition, users may track types of referral incidents and action summary by school and grade level.

Downloads

The reports are Excel spreadsheets listing student demographic information for use by school officials or photography vendors.

Elementary Literacy Assessment System

The reports show the most recent Elementary Literacy Assessment System results for students in grades K-4. (NOTE: The reports also show grades 5 and 6 results if the data is entered into **EDW for Teachers** through the Elementary Literacy Assessment System Data Entry link.

HOT PICKS FOR STARTING THE SCHOOL YEAR (Continued)

FCAT (Most Recent)-RTFSA0033

The report may be used to group students in tutorial and/or enhancement classes. Users are able to view students' performance on FCAT Reading, Math, Writing, and Science tests, Developmental Scores (DSS), and Gains.

Graduation Status-RSSOA0034

The report is used to track students' mastery, graduation, and retake status. The report does not consider special diploma criteria. (Note: This report is only valid for 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grade students.)

Historical Reports (Available to principals only)

The reports are used to review previous student data.

Monitoring Reports

The reports display progress of school-wide targets for A+ & AYP indicating the FCAT Reading, Math, Writing, and Science results compared to self and others and subgroups' proficiency, participation, and Safe Harbor data. The reports also provide a one-year comparison of the school's overall data in percentages.

Pupil Progression

The reports track students' academic progress in elementary and secondary schools. In addition, reports showing a summary of retained students by grade level and without mastery may be accessed from the Pupil Progression menu.

SAI (Current)-RSTOA0071

The report is used to view current SAI priority students and their assessment data in grades 2 and 3.

Scorecard

The Scorecard includes matrices and graphs that provide the user with an overview on how the District, areas, and schools performed on Key Results 1 through 3 and 5 through 9. The user can choose between two- and five-year statistical analyses of student group performance and gap performance between groups. It also contains drill-throughs to more detailed information.

Student Schedules-RISOA0055

The report shows the current schedule for each student.
