[Create Data Cards Using New EDW and EDW for Teachers](#) - This activity assists educators with learning how to use the Comma-separated value (CSV) feature through **EDW for Teachers** and Excel mail merge to create data cards to track students' academic progress. Educators should have knowledge of the Excel program. (4 possible inservice points)
