

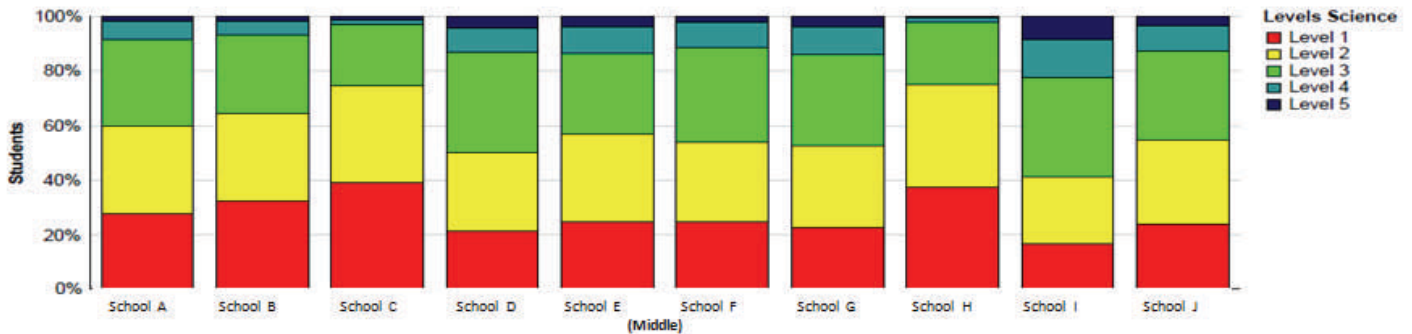
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Got GRAPHS?

There are multiple sort and filter capabilities which include demographics, time periods, participation, location, and levels. Below is the Diagnostic Locations by Science Levels - PTODA0204 graph with Diagnostic Science performance levels showing the percentages for ten schools. The pathway for **NEW EDW** users only is: **Families>>Test Results and Other Assessment Information>> FCAT>> Graphs>>FCAT Graphs.**

<u>Individual Student Form—RSSOA0082</u>	Student listing showing a profile detailing demographics, attendance, discipline, grades, testing, and special programs for the student.
