## 1. Have a Device

Virtual instruction content can be accessed from any internet-connected device however laptop devices are preferred. Please call your school for more information if you do not have a device. Families are able to borrow a device for each level (Elementary, Middle, & High) that their students attend.



## 2. Have Internet Access

A reliable broadband connection will be necessary to access course content. Comcast is offering two free months of internet and can be reached at 1-855-846-8376 or [www.internetessentials.com](http://www.internetessentials.com). Other options can be found at <http://l.sdpbc.net/6ry6x>.

## 3. Know Your Student Username and Password

Default student usernames within the District are each student's eight-digit student ID number with an "S" in front. For assistance resetting a password contact the IT Service Desk at 561-242-4100.



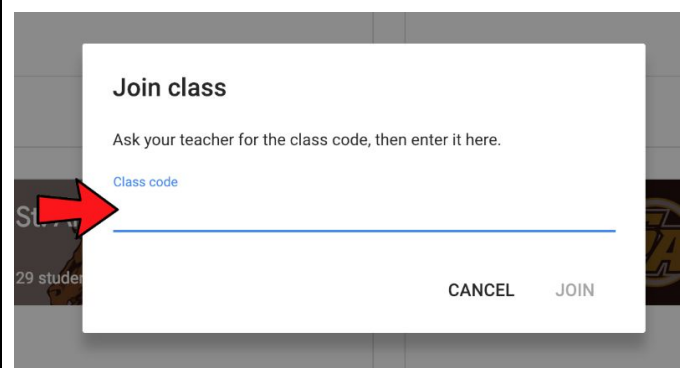
## 4. Connect to the District Portal

Visit [mysdpbc.org](http://mysdpbc.org) to log into the District Portal.



## 5. Click on Google Classroom Portal Tile

Type "Google" into the search bar on the landing page and click on the Google Classroom icon.



## 6. Have Classroom Code

Many teachers add their students to their Google Classroom, but if yours has not, check your child's email for classroom codes, or contact the school or teacher for the codes.
