Immunization Requirements**

Florida Certificate of Immunization, Form DH 680, is the only document that the schools are permitted to accept as proof of immunization.

ATTENTION PARENTS: If your child is going into K or 7<sup>th</sup> grade next year, he/she may need vaccines. Please get them now- DO NOT WAIT.

**Grade Specific Requirements**

Licensed Child Care Facilities and Family Day Care Homes

Children entering or attending Licensed Child Care Facilities and Family Day Care Homes shall have received as many of the following age-appropriate immunizations as are medically indicated in accordance with the current Recommended Childhood Immunization Schedule:

- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
- Polio (OPV or IPV)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Varicella (VZV)
- Haemophilus Influenza, type B (Hib)
- Pneumococcal Conjugate (Prevnar) for children age 2 to 59 months
- Hepatitis B (Hep B) (Recommended)

Pre-K Programs (age appropriate doses as indicated)

- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
- Polio (OPV or IPV)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Haemophilus Influenza, type B (Hib)
- Hepatitis B (Hep B)
- Varicella (VZV)

Kindergarten - 12th Grade

- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP) - 5 doses
- Polio (OPV or IPV) – 3, 4 or 5 doses (the last one after age 4 for K)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) - 2 doses
- Hepatitis B (Hep B) - 3 doses

Kindergarten to 10th Grade

Varicella - 2 doses or provider verification of Chickenpox disease history on form DH 680

7th Grade - 12th Grade

Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis booster (Tdap) - 1 dose

11th Grade - 12th Grade

Varicella - 1 dose or provider verification of Chickenpox disease history on form DH 680
